

## Daisy chain head band pattern

I love making these daisy's (which I originally created for a friends wedding). The airy pattern gives a beautiful summery shape and they are really quick to make so you'll have a fist full of flowers in no time.

### Materials

Stylecraft Special DK 1 ball gold and 1 ball white  
Size 4 crochet hook.

### Initial loop

Using gold, ch 3 then join with a slip stitch into the first chain to join. You now have a loop which you will work into for the next round.

### Round 1

ch 3 (counts as one tr), tr into the loop, ch 2. Repeat [2 tr, ch 2] 4 times. Slip stitch into the top of your ch 3 to join and then tie off your gold yarn. You should now have a wheel shape with 5 spokes coming out from the centre.

### Round 2

Join the white yarn with a slip stitch into one of the ch 2 spaces. Starting in the same ch 2 space repeat [2 tr, 1 dtr, 2 tr, sl st, st st into the next ch 2 space] five times finishing with a sl st into the sl st you started with. You now have 5 petals. Tie off your yarn and weave in all ends and you're finished!

That's it! You've made your first daisy. Mine came out as 4 cm across but don't worry if yours are bigger or smaller they will still make a lovely head band. If they are very big then use fewer daisies to make your head band. If they are small just make a few more! A child's head band needs to be about 43 cm long, so I have made eleven daisies and sewn them side by side to form my head band.
